How Does It Work?

In order to make a blanket, go online to the Sign-Up-Genius and select what type of fleece you would like (teen or child, boy or girl) and when you would like to pick up your to-go bag of Project Linus supplies to bring home.

What is in the to-go supply bag?

Your bag will contain:

- *all the fleece needed for your project*
- *instructions sheets for making no-sew blankets*
- *a plastic bag for the finished product*
- *an informational sheet about Project Linus*

At home, you will need to a pair of sharp scissors, a ruler, masking tape, and a pen.

Where do I pick up the supplies and drop off the finished blanket (s)?

*Pick up your supplies (labeled with your name) and drop off your finished blanket (s) at Mia Egelberg's house, address provided when you register. There will be a plastic tub on her front steps labeled "Project Linus." Mia will collect all of the finished blankets and pass them on to Doris Smith, our local Project Linus leader! **BLANKETS ARE DUE BY FEB 19th***
