General Information About HOPE:

With the assistance and support of a host of volunteers, HOPE opened the doors of its first Soup Kitchen in 1984. Since its early days, HOPE has grown to become the largest emergency Food Pantry and Soup Kitchen in the region. Although HOPE Community Services was founded to respond to hunger in the community, it quickly became apparent that food was not the only thing our clients were lacking. Clothing, language skills, emotional support, immigration services, and other daily necessities were also needed. HOPE Community Services expanded its services to meet the needs of its diverse client population.

Food Pantry

The Food Pantry is open to residents of New Rochelle who meet certain criteria based upon number in household and income. Registration is required and held on pantry dates. Groceries are purchased from the Food Bank for Westchester and are donated by food stores, schools, houses of worship and individuals. The food packages distributed help our residents avoid using rent money for food, thereby helping to prevent homelessness.

Pantry bags are given out on select Wednesday mornings between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. OR Wednesday in the afternoon between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Soup Kitchen

The Soup Kitchen serves meals during the week from Monday through Friday.

The Soup Kitchen currently provides to-go service from 5:00pm to 6:00pm. Each guest receives a container with a hot meal that varies nightly along with a take home bag of food. All are welcome to join us.
