

22:1 God put Abraham to the test, saying to him, "Abraham." He answered, "Here I am."






22:14 And Abraham named that site יהוה-yireh, whence the present saying, "On the mount of יהוה there is vision."

22:16 and said, "By Myself I swear, יהוה declares: Because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your favored one,



Binding of Ishmael in the Quran



The Islamic holiday, *Qurbani Id* (or *Id Al-Adha*), is known as the "Sacrifice Festival." Muslims celebrate this "great feast of sacrifice" on the tenth day of the last month of the Muslim year. According to their doctrinal scheme, this day celebrates the willingness of Abraham to sacrifice his son by Hagar, *Ishmael*.

And when [the child] had become old enough to share in his [father's] endeavors, the latter said: "O my dear son! I have seen in a dream that I should sacrifice thee: consider, then, what would be thy view!" [Ishmael] answered: "O my father! Do as you are commanded: you will find me, if God so wills, among those who are patient in adversity.

And We ransomed him with a tremendous sacrifice and left him thus to be remembered among later generation. "Peace be upon Abraham!"

Temple on Mount Moriah




2 Chronicles 3:1, Solomon built the first temple on Mount Moriah

Built around 957 BCE and destroyed 587 BCE


II Temple build 516-350 BCE and destroyed 70 CE

Jesus' crucifixion was near Mount Moriah, but we can be sure it didn't take place on Mount Moriah.






Modern Religious Importance of Jerusalem
