## Registration

All services are open seating and unreserved. Services will begin promptly, as scheduled. All onsite services and programs **REQUIRE ADVANCE REGISTRATION**, except for LiveStream, which does not require registration. The deadline for all High Holy Days reservations is **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12TH**



## Name Tags

Name tags will be mailed to members and guests after registration for onsite services before Erev Rosh Hashanah. For everyone's safety, your name tag and a photo ID will need to be presented.



## Guests

High Holy Days services are open to all, but security procedures demand that everyone have a name tag (ages 13+). They are available to anyone who registers. We ask that you use the enclosed card or go online if you plan on bringing guests with you to services.
